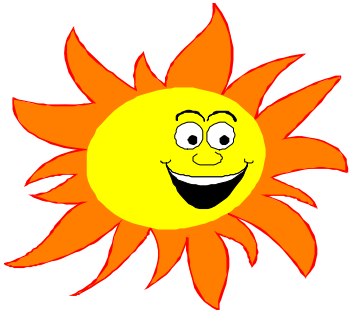


WADING POOLS 2008



POOL LOCATIONS:

Inwood Terrace Park - Inwood Terrace
Recreation Center - Stillwell Avenue
Westview Park - Westview Place
Firemen's Park - Whiteman and Gerome
Coytesville Park - Sixth Street

OPERATING HOURS:

OPENING DAY – June 30, 2008 CLOSING DAY – August 22, 2008
OPEN 7 DAYS A WEEK, 11:00 A.M. THROUGH 5:00 P.M.
(WEATHER PERMITTING)

NO ONE IS PERMITTED WITHIN THE POOL ENCLOSURE EXCEPT DURING REGULAR POOL OPERATING HOURS.

MEMBERSHIP RULES:

Memberships to Fort Lee Wading Pools are available to Fort Lee Residents Only. Members will receive an identification badge, which must be worn at all times at the wading pools. ID badges are **NOT** transferable. Violation of this rule can result in a suspension of pool privileges. Should an ID badge be lost, it must be reported to the Recreation Office.

GUESTS:

Guests will not be permitted in the wading pools unless accompanied by a member. Two guest badges will be issued to each family at the time of registration.

ADMISSION OF CHILDREN:

Children under eight (8) years of age will not be permitted in the wading pools unless accompanied by a parent or chaperone who is at least twelve (12) years old. The wading pool is for youngsters twelve (12) years of age and under. NO ONE OVER THE AGE OF TWELVE (12) WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE WADING POOLS.

WADING POOL ATTENDANTS:

There is a wading pool attendant assigned to each pool. He/she is assigned to the pool to ensure the rules of conduct and membership are followed. **Pool attendants are not lifeguards!** Therefore, every child in the pool should be properly chaperoned. The attendants will be glad to assist you in any way they can. (All attendants are certified for CPR and First Aid.) If you have any problems or need further assistance, you may contact the Recreation Office at (201) 592-3612, Monday through Friday, 9:00 A.M. through 4:00 P.M.

WADING POOL BADGE REGISTRATION HOURS:

Evening registration for Wading Pool Badges will be held from Monday, June 16th to Friday, June 27th from 3:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M. at the Recreation Center. Thereafter, registration will be held at the Recreation Office from 9:00 A.M. to 3:30 P.M. weekdays for the duration of the summer. **Proof of Fort Lee residency will be required at time of registration.** This must be a lease, deed, property tax bill, maintenance agreement, most recent cancelled rent check or maintenance check or an identification card issued by the Fort Lee Community Center. **NO DRIVERS LICENSES OR UTILITY BILLS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** This information must be presented every year to renew registration.

RULES OF CONDUCT

The Fort Lee Wading Pools can be a source of leisure time enjoyment if everyone abides by a few simple rules. Please make sure that your children and guests are familiar with the following regulations. Violation of these rules may result in loss of wading pool privileges:

1. You must have a badge to enter the pool area. Badges must be worn at all times while at the wading pools.
2. All children under 8 years of age must be accompanied by a guardian or designated chaperone in the pool area. No one over 12 years of age will be allowed in the pools.
3. Any person showing evidence of any communicable skin disease, sore or inflamed eyes, cold, nasal or ear discharges, open blisters, cuts, or any other communicable diseases shall be refused admittance to the pool.
4. Children will not be allowed in wading pools wearing diapers, unless covered by rubber pants. The Recreation Department suggests Swim Diapers.
5. Food and beverages (including coolers and any kind of thermos) are not permitted within the pool enclosure.
6. **Smoking is PROHIBITED within the pool enclosures as per Board of Health Ordinance #99-01. Violators will be fined.**
7. No roughness, rowdiness, unnecessary splashing or other poor conduct, which affects the safety and enjoyment of others, will be permitted.
8. **RUBBER RAFTS AND INNER TUBES WILL NOT BE PERMITTED.**
9. Toys, rubber balls, etc. will be allowed when attendance permits. The attendant on duty will determine this.
10. Diving and jumping from deck areas are prohibited.
11. Animals are not permitted in the park, including the pool enclosure.
12. Anyone harassing pool attendants, or violating the rules will have their pool privileges suspended.
13. Neither the Borough of Fort Lee nor any of its departments or employees will assume responsibility for lost or stolen items. **DO NOT** bring valuables to the pool!
14. The Fort Lee Recreation Department or its authorized agents shall have the power to close the pool whenever the safety or health of the participants is endangered or when the efficiency of pool operation becomes a factor.

These rules are in addition to New Jersey Bather's Rules, N.J.S.A. 8:26-5.4 as posted on large signs in the pool areas.
